

This flyer has important information regarding outdoor water meter radio transmitters in the City of Crystal. Property owners are responsible for paying all costs associated with damaged or lost transmitters.

## Property owners and siding contractors be aware:

Property owners and siding contractors should proceed with caution during home siding projects in Crystal. Radio transmitters (see right) are affixed to the exterior of buildings in the city. The units are wired into homes and transmit water meter readings to city software for utility billing.

To have a radio transmitter moved or removed, set up an appointment with the Crystal Public Works Department at 763-531-1139, <a href="mailto:publicworks@crystalmn.gov">publicworks@crystalmn.gov</a>.

## The responsibility of property owners

Property owners are responsible for all costs if a radio unit or its wires are damaged, lost or thrown away, or if the unit is not operating properly due to negligence or damage caused by the property owner or anyone else working at the home.

Property owners are also responsible for setting up appointments for city staff to make any necessary repairs.
